Chairperson Lindley-Myers called the meeting to order.

There were no public comments.

Representative Griffith made a motion to approve the open session minutes of the July 27, 2023, regular MCHCP Board of Trustees meeting. Commissioner Zellers seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Fischer presented the fiscal year (FY) 2025 appropriation requests to be presented to Office of Administration.

Director Nickelson made a motion to accept staff recommendation for an FY 2025 MCHCP department core request for HB 5, Employee Benefits in the amount of \$485,319,472 and a new decision item (NDI) of \$39,100,683. The combined FY 2025 core and NDI requests total \$524,420,155. In addition, an FY 2025 request of \$4,069,017 to Lincoln University to be included by Lincoln in HB 3 was presented. The combined requests represent a need of \$528,489,172

to meet estimated FY 2025 expenses. Commissioner Zellers seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Ms. Fischer presented the financial update. She reviewed August 2023 results.

Representative Griffith made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Zellers seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned.
